

# Alumni Employment

## Professional Education Unit

### SUNY Brockport

The following tables include the alumni employment rates of SUNY Brockport’s teacher preparation programs. Data are gathered using an alumni survey, and publicly available employment databases and websites. Data are gathered one and a half to two years post-graduation. Data are aggregated by program, and by initial (initial certification) and advanced (professional certification) level programs. For programs that had less than 10 respondents, “low n” is shown, which represents a low number of candidates. Their data are not shared publicly to preserve confidentiality. The programs with “low n” are included in the sub-total and total data. We also include another local 4-year institution’s results as a benchmark.
